**This shopping list is designed for a single lot (30 by 100 feet).**

## Tools + Resources

### Suggested Tools

- **Safety Gear:** Gloves, heavy work boots, tall socks, pants, long sleeve shirts, dust masks, protective eye wear, ear plugs, and hard hats (if using heavy machinery)
- **Garden Tools:** Spades, shovels, rakes, trash bags, and wheelbarrows
- Hacksaw and Screwdriver

### Potential Water Sources

- Garden Hose with potential extension hose
- Sprinkler
- Downspout Disconnect (shown in lot design)

## Materials List

### Materials

- Imported Drainage Soil, 11.5 cubic yards
- Mulch or Wood Chips, 6 cubic yards
- Downspout Disconnect: Standpipe cap, downspout elbow, downspout connection pipe, rubber cap, and hose clamp

### Planting

- Swamp Milkweed, 5 pots
- Purple Cornflower, 3 pots
- Blue Flag Iris, 5 pots or bulbs
- Bee Balm, 3 pots
- Black-Eyed Susan, 5 pots
- Green Gem Boxwood, 10 pots

### Rain Garden

- Rain Garden Mix, 1 pounds of seed
- Annual Cover Crop, 1 pounds of seed
- Germination Blanket, 2 rolls (8 by 112.5 feet)

## Remaining Lot (Optional)

### Groundcover

- Low-Maintenance Fescue Mix, 10 pounds of seed
- Germination Blanket, 3 rolls (8 by 112.5 feet)
