The shopping list provides a breakdown of potential materials, tools, and resources required to construct this lot design.

This shopping list is designed for a single lot (30 by 100 feet).

Tools + Resources

Suggested Tools

- **Marking Paint and Tape Measure**
- **Safety Gear:** Gloves, heavy work boots, tall socks, pants, long sleeve shirts, dust masks, protective eye wear, ear plugs, and hard hats (if using heavy machinery)
- **Garden Tools:** Spades, shovels, rakes, trash bags, and wheelbarrows
- **Truck,** to pick-up trees and mulch
- **Ball Cart,** for moving heavy trees

Potential Water Sources

- **Garden Hose** with potential extension hose
- **Sprinkler**
- **Rain Barrel** in addition to other water source

Materials

- **Mulch or Wood Chips,** 1 cubic yard

Planting

- **Redbud,** 1 pot or balled and burlapped
- **Sugar Maple,** 2 pots or balled and burlapped
- **Black Cherry,** 2 pots or balled and burlapped
- **Horse Chestnut,** 2 pots or balled and burlapped
- **Hawthorn,** 2 pots or balled and burlapped
- **Balsam Fir,** 2 pots or balled and burlapped

Remaining Lot (Optional)

Groundcover

- **Low-Maintenance Fescue Mix,** 15 pounds of seed
- **Germination Blanket,** 4 rolls (8 by 112.5 feet)
